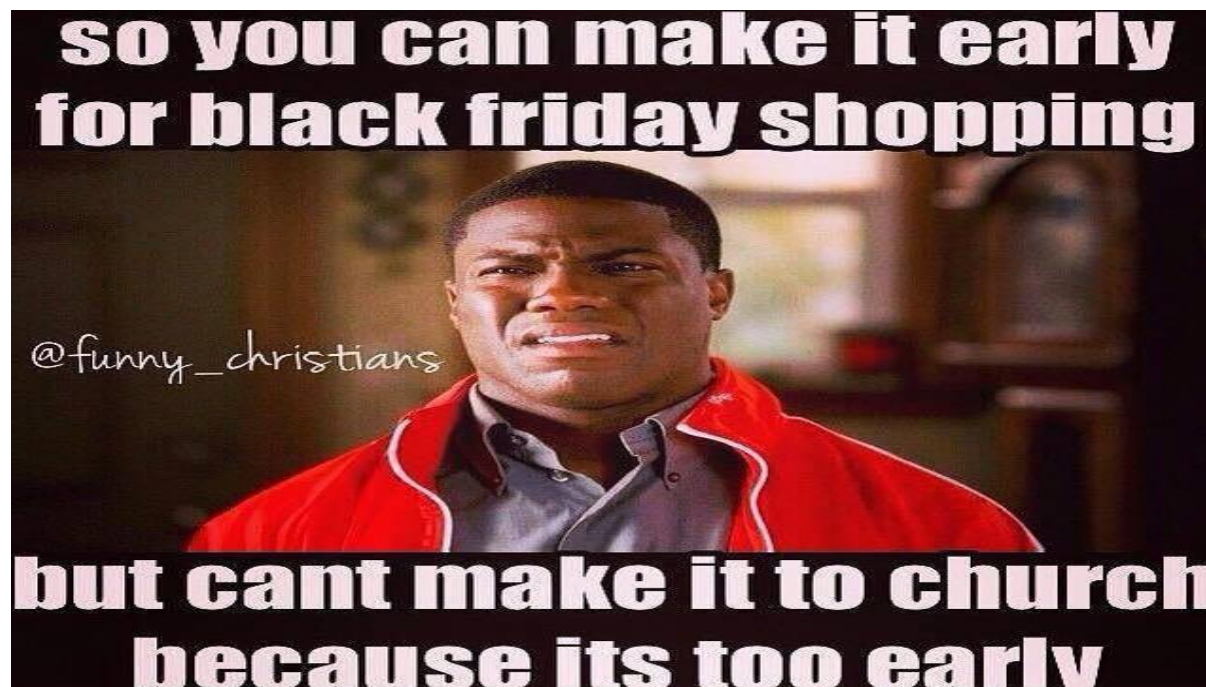
THE BISHOP IS COMING TO THE NE DISTRICT – WILL YOU BE THERE TO HEAR WHAT SHE HAS TO SAY?
