LEARNING

Every church wants to be warm, hospitable and welcoming to guests and visitors, and every church can remember guests and visitors that came once only to never come back again. Even with our best intentions in mind, many congregations don't consider the questions that guests have in mind but never ask.

No matter how inspiring worship is, regardless of how great the coffee after church might be, guest readiness is about more than worship and hospitality, it's about the unspoken rituals and routines, the insider and outsider language, the confusing signs and symbols that members take for granted and guests don't understand. Imagine going to a restaurant and having an amazing meal, only to have a waiter tell you that you're sitting at someone's favorite table so it would be best if you moved, and it's

fine that you brought kids with you, but they should probably eat somewhere else if they make any noise. The restaurant might make amazing food, but if the experience is bad, patrons are unlikely to return.

On October 27th from 10 am to 3 pm, the Northeast District and Waterloo First UMC will be hosting Jason Moore as he presents a seminar on **“5 Things Your Visitors are Thinking but Won’t Ask”**. This hands-on seminar will help congregations better connect with guests and visitor’s so churches can build lasting relationships.

Our presenter, Jason Moore, is an author, speaker and worship church who is passionate about helping. He has designed worship with Adam Hamilton, Brian McLaren, Michael Slaughter, Tony Campolo, Len Sweet and many more. Jason was an animator and illustrator for the worship design team at Ginghamburg Church for a number of years and in addition to his seminar and consulting ministry, Midnight Oil, Jason works part-time as the Creative Worship Specialist for the Miami Valley District of the United Methodist Church in Dayton, Ohio.

UMCOR Information update:

Updated information for Ingathering, 2018

(please see that this information gets to the person(s) who are assembling kits asap.)

You may or may not be aware that UMCOR has changed a few things regarding both the hygiene and school kits. Here are differences and changes we need to be aware of (as of Aug 20, 2018).

Hygiene kits – no metal nail files or emery boards. **ONLY fingernail or toenail clipper.**

10 band-aids, instead of the 6 previously asked for.

Folding directions are in ingathering book, and slide packet into 1-gallon zip lock bag and close.

School kits – kits are to be **packed in 2-gallon zip lock bags** (instead of cloth school bags.)

kits are to contain **3 one-subject notebooks, AND a package of loose-leaf paper**

(Wide ruled or college rule accepted).

Stack paper, put smaller items on top and slide into bag, burp and close.

THIS YEAR ONLY – if you have school kits assembled with just the spiral notebooks, we will still send them. If you can add a pkg of loose leaf, great! Next year will be different. Many did not realize they are asking for BOTH kinds of paper.

THIS YEAR – if you have cloth bags you have packed the school supplies in, you may bring them as they are. DO NOT use both plastic and the cloth bag. Keep kits in cloth bags and kits in plastic separated so they can be boxed for shipping, but, add the numbers together on the remittance sheet – they all have the same value.

If you have unused cloth bags, consider donating them locally or sending them to Midwest Mission, 1001 Mission Drive, Pawnee IL 62558. You may also bring them to their truck at Annual Conference.
